Blue London swirl Comments: In the 1960s, the general policy in the UK was not to duplicate album tracks on singles in order to avoid that the fans had to buy the same songs twice! This was the reason why these two stand-out tracks from "THEIR SATANIC MAJESTIES REQUEST" never made it there onto a single. But in the USA and other countries, no one (not least the local record company affiliates) seemed to mind.
